4-H Council meetings are held the First Wednesday of every month, 7pm at the Extension Office. All enrolled Volunteers are members of the 4-H Council. You do not need to be elected to attend 4-H Council meetings.

4-H Enrollment Information

- **Member dues** remain the same . . . \$7.00/1st project; \$5.00/each additional project
- **NEW:** A late fee \$10.00 per child re-enrolling after December 1, 2009
- **NEW:** No re-enrollments accepted after January 1, 2010
- **NEW:** *The Clover* is a two-year publication. If you take one, be sure to save it for next year's enrollment process. We will not receive additional copies from the State 4-H Office.
- **NEW:** Beginning Foods replaced with 4-H Cooking 101, 4-H Cooking 201, 4-H Cooking 301. There is not a leader guide for this series, follow member book.
- **New Projects Offered:** Montana 4-H Western Heritage (*includes Cowboy Action 4-H Shooting*), Wildlife Conservation, Babysitting, Communications, Videography, Theatre Arts, Visual Arts, Centennial Project, Citizenship, Up for the Challenge Lifetime Fitness, Healthy Decisions, Fast Foods, Meat Goat
- **New Materials this year for current projects:** Home Environment, Knitting, Crochet, Quilting, Exploring 4-H
- **Missoula County projects not listed in *The Clover*:** Llama/Alpaca, Cake Decorating, Western Games (horse), Trail Ride (horse); Mini Horse Level 1-3 in Horsemanship, Jumping, Obstacle & Driving
- **Shooting Sports:** Youth must be 9 by October 1, 2009, except in the new Cowboy Action, members must be 12 by October 1, 2009. Shooting Sports members ***must*** work with a leader who is certified by the State 4-H Office in the discipline they wish to study. Missoula County 4-H members ***cannot*** currently enroll in Muzzle Loading. Since not every club has certified shooting sports leaders in every discipline, we will provide as many county-wide opportunities as possible, but these will not take place as regularly as Club meetings.
- **Parents:** If your child enrolls in a Project for which your 4-H Club has no Project Leader, you are expected to serve as your child's Project Leader for that Project.
- **NEW: Animal Projects:** All 4-H Animal Projects (Livestock, Horse, etc.) will require the new Montana 4-H Animal Project Waiver forms. These forms will be sent to those members who enroll in applicable projects.
- **Leaders: NEW:** Direct Volunteers (those who provide face-to-face, unsupervised contact with youth) must be approved through the [Montana 4-H Volunteer Certification process](#). All other Leader fees remain the same as last year:
 - \$1.00 leader insurance (*or*) > optional, but recommended
 - \$2.00 horse leader insurance > optional, but recommended
 - \$5.00 leader's dues > optional, see below
 - [\\$12.00 Volunteer Cert. Fee](#) > [required for all Direct Volunteers](#)

Leader's Dues are for membership in the MT4-H Volunteer Council. Your dollars are utilized by the Montana 4-H Council to support the Ambassador program, State & National 4-H Congress, Citizenship Washington Focus, Montanans for 4-H Legislative Breakfast, Red Lab, Montana 4-H Leadership Forum, and more. Your dues help us support 4-H youth and Leaders.
