Campers should provide their own horse. A very limited number of horses MAY be available on a first come/first served. Campers and their families have the choice to stay on grounds Friday night and camp in their own RVs or tents. However, if your horse stays overnight in a stall, you must have someone responsible to stay with them overnight as well. So, if you leave, your horse/s must leave too. Also, due to another event at the venue that weekend, electrical hookups are not guaranteed. If electrical hook ups are available, horse committee members will be given priority followed by first come, first served. Lunch on Saturday will be provided by Missoula County 4-H. All other meals are on your own.

**How many stalls will you need?** \_\_\_\_\_ Please limit to horse stalls only. Stalls can be utilized for tack, etc., if there are enough available at the start of camp. One bag of shavings is provided for the stall. All campers will be expected to clean their stalls before leaving the grounds at the conclusion of camp.

**Registration Fee:** Camp fees are \$90 per camper. Families with multiple campers get a \$10 discount for every rider after the first (e.g. first rider is \$90 and 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, etc. riders are \$80 ea.)
