### **New and Notable:**

- New 4-H Year started October 1st:
  - Everyone (members and volunteers) who plans to continue their 4-H involvement in the 2022-23 4-H year needs to re-enroll online at <a href="https://4h.zsuite.org/">https://4h.zsuite.org/</a>
    - ZSuite's offices are in Florida and they have been recovering from Hurricane Ian. There are some glitches with re-enrollment at the moment, so maybe wait a few days to start.

  - NEW in '22: All 4-H Volunteers will need to complete the 4-H Volunteer Orientation online through
     ZSuite this year. It's in 4 segments that are supposed to be 15 minutes each. You can start and stop and it tracks your progress, so you don't have to sit and do it all at once.

### - Fair Wrap-up:

- Set-up Deposits: The Club Leaders and Superintendents are double-checking my list for mistakes, but I
  believe I have the final list of whose Fair Set-up Deposits will be cashed because you weren't able to (or
  chose not to) help with any of the Fair-related setups.
  - We always miss a few, so don't panic, but do check the list when it comes out. We'll wrap these up asap.
  - There are quite a few names on the list who didn't help with setup, AND didn't pay a setup deposit. We're going to have to change our system next year, because that defeats the whole purpose. We need that \$25 from those who can't help with setup to pay for the supplies for those who are there doing the set-ups.
- Livestock Sale checks: We had another record-breaking 4-H/FFA Livestock Sale, totaling more than \$737K!
  - Beef checks are out. Check with your Club Leader, or contact Deidad at the Extension Office 258-4201.
  - Sheep/Goat/Hog/Rabbit/Poultry checks historically come out no later than November 1<sup>st</sup>, but have been out mid-October recently. Club Leaders will be notified.
  - PLEASE CASH YOUR CHECK. Checks are Void after 90 days, and it will cost you \$35 to get a check re-issued due to bank fees.

  - All remaining items are in Campbell's office at the Extension Office. Please stop by asap if you recognize anything in the photos.
