Payment of Scholarship

Payment <u>will not be made</u> until you complete one term in college, university, trade or technical school, and have enrolled for the second term. A copy of documentation stating that you finished your first semester satisfactorily and documentation showing you enrolled for a second term can be turned in to Colleen at the Extension Office by mail, email or fax.





- Signed and completed scholarship application form
- A copy of your current **high school transcript** is required at the time the scholarship application is due.
- Typed double-spaced essay not more than one page entitled "Because of 4-H...." Talk about how 4-H has impacted your life - things you have learned, things you have done, how you have changed, etc.
- At least two letters of recommendation. One letter must be from a person familiar with your 4-H involvement.
- Up-to-date 4-H record book. (Completed to May 1st of this year) Call Campbell if you have questions about the specifics of this one.
- List of your 4-H projects, including years. For example: Market Beef: 2018-23 Quilting: 2016, 2019 Cooking: 2016-2019
- 4-H Resume (see Sample Resume page):
 - 4-H leadership positions
 - 4-H activities
 - 4-H honors
 - 4-H awards
 - 4-H community service
 - Non-4-H leadership positions, activities, honors, awards, community service, work experience, and other relevant activities.

- Be a graduating high school senior with a minimum 2.5 GPA.
