

### Farm Animal Emergency Preparedness Worksheet

Like Dwight Eisenhower said, "Plans are useless, but planning is indispensable"! This worksheet, brought to by Montana State University Extension, is designed to help you begin the emergency or disaster planning process for your equine, livestock, and other pets. We hope that the process of planning for an emergency and sharing that plan with your farm network will save lives.

#### How to use this worksheet

- ✓ Make a list of emergency situations that are most likely to affect your farm. How does each plan differ?
- ✓ Draw a farm site map and share with emergency responders.
- ✓ Post the list of emergency phone numbers in a public place(s).
- Contact your insurance agent to see if emergency preparedness planning can offer a discount.
- ✓ Communicate this plan annually with farm employees, clients, and neighbors. Could they initiate the plan without you?


- Bulk or packaged chemical or fertilizer storage
- Dangerous animals
- Bulk fuel storage (i.e. propane tanks)
- Open manure storage
- o Retail or agritourism facilities

- o On farm or public bridges/gates/lanes with limited capacity
- Nearby schools, churches, subdivisions, ect
